



Annual Court Summer Mass and Picnic


Thank you to Corrine Clifford for her hospitality in hosting this event. We had a wonderful time!

This is a great reason to celebrate. On October 20th the 11:00 am Mass will be celebrated for the Catholic Daughters at St. Mary Parish. Please




June 3rd was the Reception of new members. Please keep these young women of the Campus Court in your prayers as they begin the new school year. May God Bless them in all their works of Charity.
